## School Supplies 2019-2020

### 9th-12th graders:

- Sturdy 3-ring binder (1½" or larger) with 8-tab pocket dividers and 1-2 folders with 3 holes to insert into binder OR 5-6 poly/plastic folders, one for each class
- Wide or college-ruled notebook paper for binder (4 packs)
- Pencils, erasers and pens for each day (buy enough for the year)
- A pencil/pen pocket or case to keep in your 3-ring binder (optional)
- 1 composition book for Spanish 1-4
- 1 graph composition book for general Biology
- Chemistry requires a 3 or 4 inch 3 ring binder, binder dividers, notecards, & scientific calculator (not graphing)
- Organic Chemistry requires a 3 or 4 inch 3 ring binder, binder dividers, notecards, and a MOLECULAR VISIONS™ ORGANIC, INORGANIC, ORGANOMETALLIC '96 ed. Model set in a green plastic box, 9"x4.5"x2", with 120 pieces in holder

    - TI-84+ graphing calculator (for students in Algebra 2, SAT Prep, PreCalculus, AP Calculus or AP Statistics) (Silver or Color edition is ok, approx \$100)
